Will wait until that quote is received before making a decision. Justin presented quotes from Hackney and Rescue One for replacing Unit 1127. The quote from Hackney was \$285,896.00 inclusive. The quote from Rescue One for a demo unit was \$327,249.00 inclusive. There will be a need for \$35,000.00 for additional equipment for either vehicle. At some point in the future, it will be necessary to replace the car.

New Business – PEOSHA is making a visit to our location to inspect our records. Nomination for two Commissioners seats for the February 18, 2012 election took place. John Gallo's term is expiring and John agreed to run again. Gwynne made a motion to nominate John Gallo for another three year term and Spike seconded it. Tony Abriola's term is also expiring, but Tony is not going to seek another three year term. A motion was made by Spike and seconded by Dom to nominate Jerome Irick to run for this three term. All in favor of these two candidates. These two names will appear on the ballot.
