Resolution # 2022-014

Authorizing Disposal of Personal Property

WHEREAS, the Fire District is the owner of various firetrucks as set forth on the attached list; and

WHEREAS, same is no longer needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Fire District wishes to dispose of same in accordance with New Jersey statute.

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Commissioners Fire District No. 2 in the Borough of Buena, County of Atlantic, as follows:

- (1) The various firetrucks are being sold in an as is condition without any express or implied warranties.
- (2) The party receiving the property shall be required to execute a Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement relative to use of same.
- (3) The Fire District shall advertise for sealed bids concerning the firetrucks in accordance with New Jersey statute. Bids shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope with the name and address of the bidder set forth on the outside thereof. Said envelope shall denote "Mini Attack" on the outside and shall be addressed to Board of Fire Commissioners, Borough of Buena Fire District No. 2, 255 Wheat Road, P.O. Box 176, Minotola, New Jersey 08341. The Fire District shall accept sealed bids on May 3, 2022 at 10:00 AM.
- (4) All bids shall be hand-delivered at the time and place stated for receipt of said bids or mailed prior thereto. No bid shall be delivered or accepted after the date and hour as designated herein and the risk of timely receipt of mailed bids is sole responsibility of the bidder. Bids mailed shall be forwarded to Board of Fire Commissioners, Buena Borough Fire District No. 2, 255 Wheat Road, Minotola, New Jersey 08341.
- (5) Said bids shall be called for and shall be received opened and read in public at the Buena Borough Board of Fire Commissioners - Fire District No. 2 Minotola Firehouse, Commissioners Meeting Room, 255 Wheat Road, P.O. Box 176, Minotola, New Jersey 08341 at 10:00 am prevailing time on May 3, 2022.

- (6) Each sealed bid shall be hand delivered or mailed in time to be received by the Board of Fire Commissioners, or to such other designated representative of the Commissioners who will be present at the opening of said bids at the time and place stated for the receipt of sealed bids. NO BID SHALL BE DELIVERED OR ACCEPTED AFTER THE DATE OR HOUR AS DESIGNATED IN THIS PUBLIC NOTICE.
- (7) A non-collusion affidavit in the usual form will be supplied with the specifications. It shall be executed by the person or corporate officers submitting the bid. Said affidavit must be properly notarized. A non-collusion affidavit must accompany each bid. THIS REQUIREMENT WILL NOT BE WAIVED.
- (8) All bids shall be accompanied by the appropriate form relative to mandatory equal employment opportunity.
- (9) Bidders are required to comply with the applicable statutory requirements and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, including but not limited to P.L. 1975, Ch. 127; P.L. 1977, Ch. 33; P.L. 1963, Ch. 150; and P.L. 1933, Ch. 277, including all amendments thereto.
- (10) No bidder may withdraw their proposal for a period of 60 days after the opening of bids; all proposals being binding upon all bidders for said 60-day period.
